When Philippe the Bold in the 14th century outlawed the cultivation of Gamay in Burgundy, it pushed the grape south to the Beaujolais region. The best wines (Cru Beaujolais) come from ten villages/areas in the foothills of the Beaujolais mountains. **Morgon** are generally earthy wines that can take on a silky Burgundian character with some age. They are generally the deepest color and show aromas of apricots and peaches. **Fleurie** often have a velvet texture with a fruity and floral bouquet. **Chiroubles** are noted for their delicate perfume that often includes aromas of violets.
